



2018-2019 JOURNEY GRANTS

Funding for 2018-2019 Journey Grants is limited. Not every student who applies will be awarded a grant.

CRITERIA FOR APPLICATION EVALUATION:

A Journey Grant project should:

- Complement a student's unique talents and interests.
- Build on what a student has learned from courses, both in major/minor and core curriculum areas, and from extracurricular experiences.
- Broaden a students' global perspective (views of academic, political, social, cultural, economic and/or other impacting environments). Global does not necessarily mean international.

The Journey Grant Review Committee may also consider feasibility (does the student have the knowledge and resources to complete the project?), impact (will the impact/results of the project be shared with a broader audience?) and financial need.

Priority will be given to applications for college-approved, faculty-led trips and projects required for the successful completion of a student's major/minor, such as study abroad.

The standard Journey Grant remains \$2,000; however, an awarded grant will not exceed a project's budget. Enhanced funding up to \$4,000 may be awarded on a limited basis, depending on the availability of funds, scope of the project, and funding justification.

APPLICATION TIMELINE:

- Application for Fall 2018 projects - Opens 5 January 2018, Closes 2 February 2018, Award Notification by 2 March 2018
- Application for Winter Break/Spring 2019 projects - Opens 3 August 2018, Closes 31 August 2018, Award Notification by 28 September 2018
- Application for Summer 2019 projects - Opens 4 January 2019, Closes 1 February 2019, Award Notification by 1 March 2019

ELIGIBILITY: Students are now eligible to apply to fund a project the summer before their third year.
